The library is free to decide which documents are available or not, judging by the material and legal condition of the documents.

Consultation of the documents is systematically subjected to the approval of a library's official.

The documents are passed as bundle or, in some cases, in boxes. During the consultation, the applicant is requested to sit in area dedicated to patrimonial collections's consultations. The condition and number of the documents will be assessed in the applicant's presence before and after handing them over.
